

SAFE PLANET FILM FESTIVAL

The Safe Planet Film Festival was held at Olympus Theatre from 27th to 29th January 2011.

The three day environmental film festival was a collaboration between Ministry of Housing and Environment, the High Commission of India, Technology, Education, Research and Rehabilitation for Environment (TERRE), Maldives Entertainment Company (MEC) and Maldives National Broadcasting Corporation (MNBC), and was inaugurated by the Minister of Housing and Environment, Hon. Mohamed Aslam.
