

LCEI Project Participated and Contribute in the Ozone2Climate Technology Expo and Industry Roundtable

The Project, Strengthening low Carbon Energy Island Strategies (LCEI) participated and contributed in the Ozone2Climate Technology Expo and Industry Roundtable held at Dharubaaruge from 14 - 16 August 2017. In the discussion during the 2nd round table session of the Expo on 14th August 2017, the progress of the project & achievements towards creating enabling environment for energy efficiency in the Maldives was presented by the Project Manager, Mr. Mohamed Inaz.

In his presentation an insight was given on the major challenges and constraints which lead to weak energy efficiency practices in the country. These include poor consumer motivation and awareness, lack of enabling policy initiatives and lack of institutional arrangements towards energy efficiency practices, poor building designs in terms of energy efficiency and lack of capacity to implement the energy efficiency measures.

The expo was inaugurated by the Minister of Environment and Energy, Honorable Thoriq Ibrahim. Ozone2Climate Technology Expo was organized by the MEE in collaboration with UN environment.
