

Ministry signs an M.O.U with FENAKA to repair the R.O plants established in 10 islands

A Memorandum of Understanding was signed between the Ministry of Environment and Energy and FENAKA Corporation to repair the R.O plants established in 10 islands on 1 July 2013. The R.O plants were placed to minimize the negative effects of the extended drought periods and lack of rainfall during the end of North-West monsoon. Under this MoU, R.O plants placed in H.A Ihavandhoo, Sh. Funadhoo, N. Velidhoo, N. Maalhendhoo, Raa. Alifushi, Baa. Hithaadhoo, L. Isdhoo, GA. Villingili and GDh. Gahdhoo will be repaired.

Minister of State for Environment and Energy, Mr. Abdul Matheen Mohamed signed this agreement on behalf of the Ministry. The Managing Director of Fenaka, Mr. Mohamed Nimal signed the MoU on behalf of FENAKA Corporation Limited.



According to the MoU, the R.O plants in these islands 10 islands are to be refurbished within 180 days.
