

Field Assessment of S.Gan Met Office as a Demonstration Building

15 February 2017

A field assessment was carried out in Addu from 14th to 15th February 2017, jointly by Project Management Unit (PMU), officials from Maldives Metrological Service (MMS) head office and Climate Change Department.

The main aim of this assessment was to facilitate developing the Gan MMS facility as an iconic green and energy efficient building.

The demonstration work when completed will largely contribute to create awareness on ways of improving our building stock and lowering carbon foot print of our buildings.

According to Gan Met Office data, a total number of 647 students and 116 teachers from 11 schools, including students from Dharumavantha School, Male' visited the facility in the year 2016 alone. Therefore the development is expected to raise awareness and promote energy efficiency and green building concept among visitors and public.
